"Pirkko Home" Rehab Center Ministry

Artem Panin, who serves at the Ruchiyok Adaptation Center, Moscow region, shares: "Since the beginning of this year, 19 people have come to us for adaptation, 16 brothers and 3 sisters. Our ministry staff is a special blessing to us. Our team consists of 5 people: me, my wife Oksana (who is responsible for the female adaptation ministry), Sergei M., Alexander S. and Andrei A. Earlier this year, Sergei was baptized and became a member of Solnechnogorsk Bible Church. He wants to continue this ministry, to be useful in the church, and to grow in the knowledge of God. Alexander and Andrei also want to make a covenant with God by baptism and are studying lessons on the foundations of the faith.



"Spiritual work with the residents after they complete rehabilitation is not an easy task and restoration takes time. They dream of a new happy life, family, work, but they are facing great trials and a real spiritual war, where it is necessary to fight the enemy - and unfortunately, there are many falls. Only a few people stay after adaptation to help with this ministry, probably 3%, so it's like in the Gospel: the harvest is plentiful - but the laborers are few.

"Our center is located at the Christian Camp & Retreat Center called 'Ruchiyok' ('Brook'), where we also work. The brothers prepare firewood, man the boiler room (and wood fired furnace), and handle upkeep and repairs. Our sisters clean the rooms, and do washing and ironing. An integral part of our ministry is trips to the church and Bible study. God blessed us with a good van, but, unfortunately, there are only 7 seats in it and we do not all fit. **This is our prayer need - transportation;** please pray about this with us. We thank God for all of you, and pray for you."



Summer Camp. "Praise God for the annual summer camp for rehab centers, held in June at a new location this year, in the Lipetsk region. There were 200 people, all delighted with God's obvious presence there. Powerful sermons were simple and understandable for everyone from the rehab centers, and for the graduates and the ministers. Everything was wonderful, and some people, being convicted by the Word, repented. There were seminars on family, finances, sanctification, being involved in a church, and personal evangelism. Pastors were available for counselling and answering questions. There were also various team contests in which we all became

very close. Praise God for this time!" - Ravil Davidov, assistant minister, Rummyantsevo Pirkko Home.
