### The Gospel Behind Barbed Wire Prison Magazine Ministry

Our magazine provides "live" communication - "Free" brothers and sisters learn about needs from reading prisoners' letters included in our magazine, and they respond by sending them clothes, medicines, and books, answering their letters, sharing advice and praying for their problems. Here is the response of one of the prisoners touched by this kindness:

"I received *The Gospel Behind Barbed Wire* magazine from you, and with it were letters from people who read an excerpt from my letter presented in the magazine. I didn't know that people were reading your magazine outside this high fence. Being among so much deception, betrayal, lying and deceit, I forgot that in this world there is compassion, kindness and love. In these letters no one condemns me; they do not reproach, do not preach and do not scold. No one tries to convert with their truth, to impose their opinion. No! People talk about their sins, about the trials and temptations that they faced, and about their path to finding God and their love for Him. People with faith pray for the salvation of my soul and for my mother's health. I am grateful to you and to everyone who responded. I hope that I will find my way to God, and find love and peace. ### RCR Recording Studio Ministry

Over the last 2 ½ years we have released **nine different programs**, and another new program is in process. These nine programs are: Choice; About God, Faith & the Church; Foundations of Faith; Practical Christianity; The Church; Heavenly Intersection; Parent Talks; Life Line; and Children's Programs.

Since the beginning of the summer we have been releasing the "Choice" video programs made at the prison ministry conference in Tatarstan. If you understand Russian, we recommend that you watch the Choice program testimony of Sergei Gavrilov, a passionate preacher who shares his great spiritual & life experiences.
