Pirkko Home "Liberation Ministry"

Igor Markov, Nikulino Pirkko Home: Our village is small, less than 30 houses. Good relations have been developed with all the residents. But recently a retired lieutenant colonel, who reacted negatively to our rehabilitation ministry, began to write complaints to the police about our rehab center and my family. Literally, this

military man started a war: he walks around the village, campaigning for people to sign statements requesting our closure, and spreading slander. In recent months, we were checked by the district administration, fire department, police, migration service, and prosecuting attorneys. Now we have warnings in our hands and a long list of fire safety violations and the obligation to take care of them. We ask you to pray with us for this difficult situation.

<u>Peter Pitsurenko, Plavsk Pirkko Home</u>: The first test of our new rehab center in winter weather is behind us. There were many difficulties, mainly due to the imperfections of the old building that we are remodeling, but trust in God and enthusiasm helped to overcome everything. <u>This summer we plan to continue construction: adding on a boiler room, and a bathroom with showers on the second floor. This is a big job, and we need help. Please pray about this. Also, the regional administration is favorable towards us and is allowing us to use the empty land neighboring ours; we will start making plans, which must begin with building a fence.</u>

A Christian sister from Moscow brought some magazines with her to Greece. One prisoner there read the magazine and saw his friend on one of the pages, and as Pastor Fouad said, the

RCR Recording Studio Ministry

<u>Ayur Vanzhilov</u>: The ministry of the RCR Studio includes the production of Christian video programs, their distribution on the Internet and on discs, the publication of sermons by Earl Poysti, and social networking with subscribers. In addition, we partner with MCC Radio in Vladikavkaz and download audio versions of testimonies from our "Choice" programs especially for their use. Constantly we receive letters from people thanking us for spiritual food and support, and many use our videos and sermons for evangelism. Over the past three months, 33 people asked for spiritual help and prayer support; and about 300 people wrote thank you notes to us.
