Ayur Vanzhilov: 2021 ended with a celebratory worship service in Moscow in honor of the 75th anniversary of RCR’s ministry (in Moscow Central Church), where we told people about the history of our ministry, about the life of Earl Poysti, and how RCR serves and ministers to people today.

Our new employees, Vladimir Gorlan and Nikita Vorotilov, have already recorded 5 videos with interviews of people on the streets of Moscow. They have talked with 60 strangers and presented each of them with New Testaments. The finished videos are also a good example of how to tell unbelievers about God through questions! Pray for Vladimir and Nikita, and for their health, as they spend the whole day on the cold street. Not many passers-by agree to be interviewed. Pray for those passers-by who hear the Word of God and for their repentance.

In the studio, we continue to work on various programs, but we’ve had some difficulties. This month, the third hard drive in the last 2 years crashed, resulting in the loss of important data we recorded for the “Choice” program, and delays in preparing new videos. Therefore, our need for purchasing new HDDs and SSDs is growing.
