Eduard Zavedevev: It is a joy to see and hear how former prisoners have been serving in churches for



many years and are engaged in evangelism in prisons. On February 17-18, 2023, a prison conference was held in Kemerovo. The prison ministers came from Siberia. Prison minister Alexander M. (pictured with our magazines) has been corresponding with us for several years. He reports: "We received two boxes of The Gospel Behind Barbed Wire magazines from you and distributed them to brothers in the prison ministry from all the cities represented. Thanks a lot! We distributed so many that we didn't have any left for ourselves! We didn't actually offer them, but so many people asked us for them! So praise God!"

Good news from Novosibirsk: Sergey S., a prison minister who uses our GBBW magazines for evangelism writes: "The doors of all prison colonies and correctional centers in the Novosibirsk region are open for ministry, is this not a harvest? Please pray with us for workers for the harvest - for new prison ministers."

Ayur Vanzhilov: In February, our YouTube channel published the testimony of Olga Bryantseva, who experienced the death of her son in the fall of 2022. This tragic incident led her to God and to the church. Her testimony is frank and heavy, but speaks of great hope in Jesus Christ. This video is very relevant today. Pray for Olga to take root in God; she has only been in church for 4 months. Here are a couple of the reviews for this program:

- My son was brutally murdered in April 2019, 6 months later my granddaughter died ... how painful it is to live with this. If I didn't know God, I wouldn't have survived. - Lydia

Pirkko Home Liberation Centers

Dima Gusev: This year the Rumyantsevo Pirkko Home turned 22 years old! Presently there are 8 residents in the program here. Pray for them to find work, and pray for the guys who have major health problems; we often have to take them to hospitals. We thank God for the faithfulness and dedication of our ministers here in the Moscow region: Nodari Mangasarov & Oleg Glazov (Rumvantsevo), Artem Panin & Ilya Davydov (Solnechnogorsk). Pray for the growth of the ministry and our investment in a new generation of ministers. To assist with these goals, we conduct training for all our Pirkko Home ministry assistants. Recently, together with rehab centers from St. Petersburg, we had another training seminar. The feedback from the brothers was excellent, many were inspired and encouraged.

In March, one of these brothers, Alexander K., was baptized at our church in Solnechnogorsk. He had undergone rehabilitation in the Kokino Pirkko Home (Bryansk region) and adaptation in Solnechnogorsk (Moscow region). Praise the Lord!
