## **Pirkko Home Liberation Centers**

<u>Vlad Fadeyev</u>, <u>Orel Pirkko Home</u>: The main goal of this ministry is to bring people to the Lord who have crippled their lives with sin, and show them the love of God, His care, and His sacrifice for everyone!

The rehabilitation ministry in Orel continues. Praise God! On June



18, we celebrated the 14<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this Pirkko Home! Our friends who support us prayerfully and financially came to the Sunday service. There was good fellowship, with thanksgiving to the Lord for the miracles that He performs in the lives of our men. And there are a lot of such miracles! For example, the roof of the Orel Pirkko Home really needs to be repaired - and God has provided for everything wonderfully - through the local church, and renovation work is scheduled for July/August! For us, this shows the love of the Father!

There are five men in the program right now. Two others have completed the rehab program: Sergey G. has left for the adaptation course in Solnechnogorsk, and upon completion he plans to return to our center to help with the ministry. Igor D. needs to go home to Uzbekistan to restore his documents, and then would also like to come back. An assistant leader is still needed here. Pray for more people to come to Pirkko Homes for help.

## The Gospel Behind Barbed Wire (GBBW) Magazine Ministry

<u>Eduard Zavedeyev:</u> We have corresponded with many of the prisoners for several years. We answer questions, publish their requests, poems, and reflections, send them magazines, New Testaments, sermons and other Christian literature, and also, at their request, we send magazines to their relatives.



In mid-June 2023, Alexander O. was released from a prison colony in the Novosibirsk Region. We started corresponding with him in 2017. He served a total of 31 years. His last term was 8 years. He repented in 2019 and asked us to send the magazine to his mother, Nina. We have been sending her the



magazine since February 2020 (she is in the photo with her son after his release). His mother is close to repentance. Every day she reads the Bible, watches broadcasts of church services and listens to sermons, and has communicated with her son Alexander on spiritual topics since he was in prison. Please pray for her repentance. Also, please pray for Alexander to continue following the Lord in his new circumstances. He now has many needs both in health and in the social sphere.

### **RCR Recording Studio Ministry**

<u>Ayur Vanzhilov</u>: May 26-28 we took a trip to Stavropol at the invitation of local ministers. It turned out to be a very rich time: we participated in the youth fellowship of the local church, made presentations on the ministry of Earl Poysti and the RCR Studio, and taught a master class on modern media ministry. Separately, the importance of personal testimony was raised, and as a result, one teenager repented after hearing my story of turning to God. This is a miracle!



God gives our RCR ministry today opportunities to be an inspiration and an example to others. Praise God!

On June 11, Natalya Chernyakova and I visited the Christian conference in Kolomna for a second time, where we recorded five testimonies for the Choice program. It is interesting that wherever we go, we are recognized, there are always viewers who thank us and bless the ministry of the RCR Studio. And for this, of course, we thank the donors and those who pray for us, because without you and without God's blessing this is impossible.
